

Annex I (Protocol) to Summary of OPERATION HOLLY 70

1. Planning.

a. Planning consisted of drafting the letter of instruction and coordinating the details with USARV Protocol, in an advisory status, and with site protocol officers. MACV protocol matters regarding the show were handled thru J-13.

b. DOD Advance Party had no additions to the OP HOLLY Letter of Instruction.

c. Throughout site surveys it was impressed on site project staffs that they would be responsible for protocol functions. Cost of any receptions would be borne by the site. List of invitees to the functions was at their discretion keeping in mind the LOI guidelines. List of invitees from nearby commands was at their discretion. Gifts to Mr. Hope and the troupe were at the discretion of the site commander.

2. Execution.

a. Camp Eagle: MG Hennessey met Mr. Hope at the Hue-Phu Bai Airport. The cast was ferried to Eagle by CH-47 and Mr. Hope, Mr. Brown and MG Hennessey with LTC Smith, DOD Project Officer went by UH-1H. General Hennessey presented a golf club to Mr. Hope on behalf of COMUSMACV. General Hennessey presented a plaque to Mr. Hope at the end of the show. No gifts were given to the cast other than hats which were distributed at their arrival. No reception was held. A hospital visit was conducted at the 85th Evac Hospital - Phu Bai. Only problem at Camp Eagle was that a list of VIP's was not presented at the arrival of the Protocol Officer and the on-site protocol officer could not be found until after the cast had arrived. Mr. Hope recognizes various VIP's from the stage. This requires that their names be placed on cue cards prior to the show with phonetic spelling. Further, Vice President Ky arrived on scene without much advance notice.

b. Freedom Hill: EG Sweeney, CG, USASUPCOM DNG, met Mr. Hope at 15th aerial port and ferried by UH-1H to Freedom Hill with General Sweeney. The remainder of the cast went by 2 CH-46's. LTG Sutherland introduced Mr. Hope on stage. Admiral McCain presented him with a golf bag at the end of the show. No reception was planned at Da Nang. A hospital visit was made to the USS Sanctuary. No gifts were presented to the troupe at Da Nang.

c. Long Binh: Commanding Officer Bien Hoa AB met Mr. Hope on arrival. The entire cast including Mr. Hope travelled by CH-47 (2) to USARV Head-shed where he was met by LTG McCaffrey. General Weyand (DEPCOMUSMACV) introduced Mr. Hope on stage, and USARV GSM presented Mr. Hope a plaque. General Weyand presided at a reception at CG Mess for Mr. Hope and Mr. Brown. MG Gettys hosted a reception at the Main Club for all the other members of the troupe. Mementoes were presented to Mr. Hope by General Weyand and Certificates of Appreciation for the troupe were boxed up for travel with them.

3. Recommendations.

a. On site protocol officers have a firm list of VIP's ready for presentation to Protocol Officer on arrival.

b. Transportation for cast should be accomplished by air (CH-47) where ever possible. Ground transportation should be made by bus whenever possible - limiting sedan use only to Mr. Hope.

4. Lessons Learned.

Hope troupe is concerned primarily with quick movement to site; not with VIP fanfare in transportation.
